Global sustainability and engagement	@Kortrijk – every semester on Monday afternoon @ Brugge – <u>only in Spring</u> on Tuesday afternoon The beginning of the 21st century is marked by profound societal changes as well as rapid social change. The complexity of the world has increased exponentially, and political, economic and sociocultural developments can at present only be analysed and understood in a global context. In this course, we focus on the 21st century competences (sustainability, international and intercultural competences, creativity and innovation, dealing with diversity etc.), with the UN Sustainable Development Goals as framework of reference. By following this course, you will gain awareness and insights into the field of global issues and world citizenship. A selection of current global issues will be presented: climate change, environmental justice, poverty and inequality, conflict and peace, migration etc. In this subject, you can choose between two different tracks: a theoretical track with a concluding research paper or a track with an action-oriented / civic engagement component. Practical training

Campus Brugge

The practical training will find place in the **wide area of the University of Applied Sciences**. Several hospitals receive Erasmus students for clinical training, depending on the specific wards asked. An internship in elderly care centers and homecare is possible. Other placements are possible depending on the availability of the hospital and the time of application.

Campus Kortrijk

The practical training for students **nursing** will mainly find place in **AZ Groeninge** (1066 beds in 2012), the main hospital in Kortrijk, that obtained the Joint Commission International (JCI)-accreditation in 2013.

Midwifery training may find place in AZ Groeninge or a hospital in the area.

Campus Roeselare

The main goal of exchange for incoming students is practical training in hospital settings. Roeselare has recently merged 2 hospitals into 1 large Hospital: AZ DELTA. It is (temporary) still located on 2 different places in the city: AZ Delta campus Bruggesteeweg (330 beds), AZ Delta campus Wilgenstraat - Westlaan (883 beds). Students doing internship in Roeselare will mostly be accommodated in Kortrijk.
