Overall aims and assessment

The module will provide students with skills, knowledge and experiences in order to increase their teaching competences with a focus on physical education, coaching and training (sport and leisure), intercultural competences, personal growth, global awareness and international knowledge related to education. Each module includes permanent assessment based on oral and/or written presentations.

Prerequisites

English language skills on a B2 level according to the Common European Framework of References for Languages (CEFR).

Language

The sport classes are mostly practical. The official language is Dutch (teachers and fellow students translate content and instruction when necessary). Papers or reports are drawn up in English. The traineeship will take place in Dutch-speaking schools, though the trainees can use English. This can be in a primary and/or a secondary school.

VICKIE 1 – Global sustainability and engagement 5 ECTS

The beginning of the 21st century is marked by profound societal changes as well as rapid social change. The complexity of the world has increased exponentially, and political, economic and sociocultural developments can at present only be analysed and understood in a global context.

In this course, we focus on the 21st century competences (sustainability, international and intercultural competences, creativity and innovation, dealing with diversity etc.), with the UN Sustainable Development Goals as framework of reference. By following this course, you will gain awareness and insights into the field of global issues and world citizenship. A selection of current global issues will be presented: climate change, environmental justice, poverty and inequality, conflict and peace, migration etc.

In this subject, you can choose between two different tracks: a theoretical track with a concluding research paper or a track with an action-oriented / civic engagement component.

VICKIE 2 – Social and intercultural competences 5 ECTS

You will learn skills for civic competence related to the ability to engage effectively with others in the public domain, and to display solidarity and interest in solving problems affecting the local and the wider community. Therefore we focus in this key on self-knowledge and on facing diversity in our way of life. The qualifications we need to

live as a citizen in the today's Europe, requires insight in the complex phenomenon of identity and the way we live as a human being in a group. We implement this on the teacher and his pupils. Facing history learns us more about the complexity of the human society. You also learn skills for guiding the process of bringing children to express themselves by means of musical language and drama. You acquire expertise in the field of possibilities of expression. You share the knowledge (as part of an intercultural group of teacher trainees) of possibilities to play with body-language, drama, rhythm and melody in language. You acquire expertise in guiding pupils in exceeding their limits, fears in the domain of expressing their feelings and inner thoughts.

VICKIE 3 – A broad view on education in Europe and Flanders 4 ECTS

Here you get a broad view on education in Flanders and Europe. We focus on the competences and attitudes of the teacher of this century and we compare educational systems and approaches from different countries. Guiding developmental and learning processes is very important in education. We focus on powerful environments for education and self-guidance of children and young people in learning situations. As teacher you will be informed about different topics on education (eg. Social skills and conflict resolution, normalisation, inclusive education, equity topics, diversity, child orientated learning, experiential learning, alternative approaches...). Coping with diversity is also a challenge in education in Europe and Flanders.

VICKIE 4 – Labs in education **3 ECTS** (One lab to choose)

4.1 Diversity in/and education - compulsory 3 ECTS

An understanding and awareness of equality and diversity is needed more than ever in our society, in schools and education. Perceptions, attitudes and practices that promote prejudice and discrimination in education should be challenged. You will look into different aspects of diversity and acquire the necessary knowledge, skills and attitudes to deal with diversity in educational settings.

4.2 Approaches of Innovative Teaching – Global Perspectives 3 ECTS

Within this course we will reflect on a range of approaches in current education while exploring different innovative approaches in education. Together we will seek to develop new approaches that enable young people to shape an interconnected future of humanity and planet. The course is given throughout different association partners in Flanders. We will visit those partners and will receive a class on what innovative approaches that institution is an expert in. In the afternoon there will be a possibility to enjoy a cultural program in the 6 different cities. Some of the topics are: educational technology, synchronous hybrid learning, the classroom expanded, transformative education, and virtual reality.

For this course you don't need to buy any syllabus, but we do expect you to travel to the different partners by train (guided).

4.3 Physical education and movement and recreation 3 ECTS

(only for future teachers physical education or trainers/instructors in a sports field)

You can follow different practical and theoretical courses concerning physical education and movement and recreation. The practical courses are given in Dutch. The theoretical courses are given in English. All the lectures of the team have a big expertise in their sports field and the special methodologies in school environment or sport clubs. You can choose this course 2 times. Options will be explained at the beginning of your stay.

This course you follow in campus Torhout (20 minutes from Bruges)

VICKIE 5 – Labs in English and education 4 ECTS

We will focus on providing guidance in sports, in education and beyond. Your skills as a future teacher in physical education will be fine-tuned. Next to this, we will focus on the growing active leisure sector in Europe. You have to make a choice between outdoor & coast, fitness & wellness or training & coaching.

5.5 Physical education (skills) 5 ECTS

This course includes both teacher training in schools as methodology and practical lessons on physical education (rhythm, athletics, swimming and ball sports). Students will be familiarized with our vision on teaching physical education and is based on skills practice. They also get the opportunity to try out and experience this actively in primary and secondary schools.

5.6 Active leisure sector (exploring in depth) 8 ECTS

For this course you have to choose of the several options in the active leisure. We offer outdoor & coast, fitness & wellness and training & coaching (soccer). The emphasis is put on skills and techniques to coach and support people in adventure sports, fitness or soccer. Next to this you will actively participate in this segment of the leisure industry. Depending on the field you choose, you will make one of the following trips:

- Outdoor and coast: destination Spain: degree in Canyoning Assistant Guide
- Fitness and Wellness: destination: The Netherlands or Belgium: exploring new fitness trends
- Training and coaching: Belgium and abroad: reputable, innovative training centres
